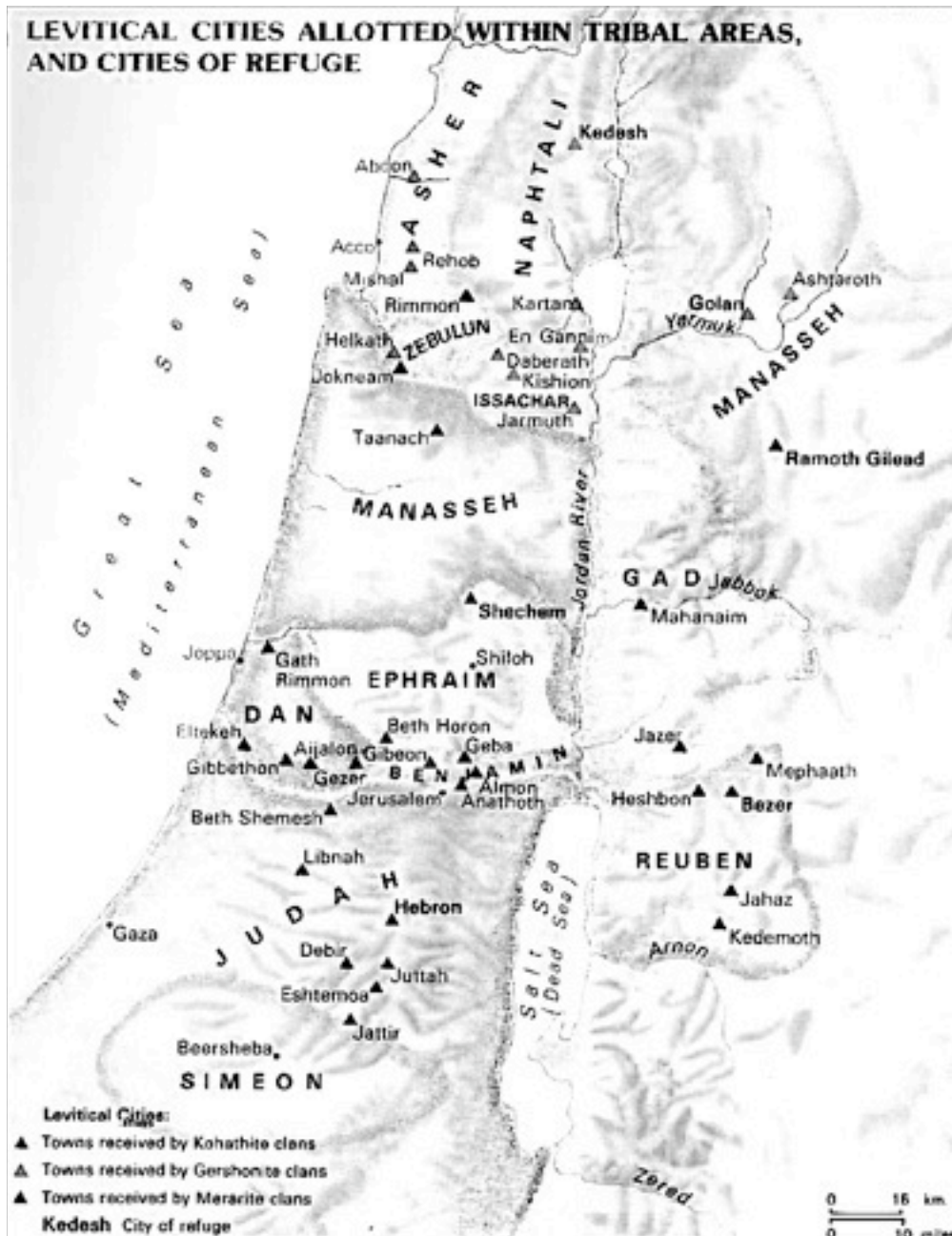




# Levitical Cities & Community Groups
